### A Little History

The first place of worship with the designation "St. Columba" was opened in 1914, and is now the Church Hall. The original purpose built Church opened in 1929 but was destroyed during an air raid in 1943.

On 17<sup>th</sup> September 1960, the current Church was opened. In 2010, St Columba's celebrated the Golden Jubilee of the new building, remembering the words of the vicar in 1960, Revd Jim Roxburgh, which are just as apt today as they were over 50 years ago.

"It's here ... to be used ... for worship.

"It is to be used too to proclaim ... that Jesus Christ is the Saviour of the world, and has reconciled God and man.

"It is to be used too to provide a place where men and women can have fellowship with God and with each other."


